

Sprayed by Skunk

If a person or an animal surprises a skunk in a situation where neither can retreat, the skunk will spray in self defense.

Skunk spray in human eyes is extremely irritating and can cause temporary blindness, but no permanent damage. Flush eyes liberally with cold water to ease irritation.

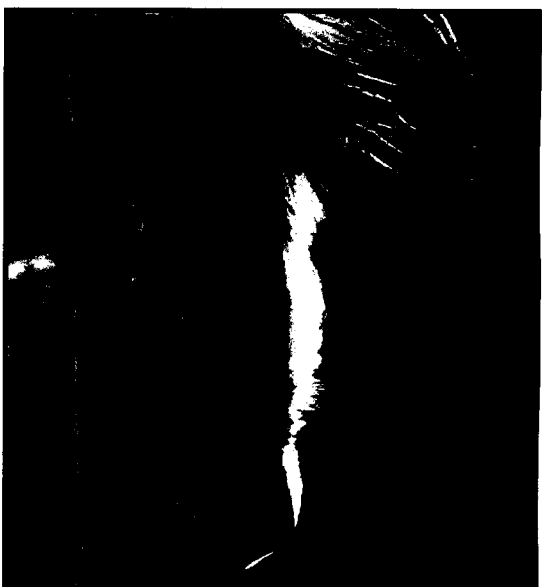
Wash skin with carboic soap and water, tomato juice, or vinegar. Another deodorizer which can be used on (dogs, skin, etc.) is One quart 3% hydrogen peroxide, ¼ cup baking soda and one tsp. Of liquid dish or laundry soap. Mix these 3 ingredients together, then dip a washrag in the solution and rub the dog, person, etc. down. Rinse and the odor will disappear **within minutes!**

You may be able to save clothing by washing repeatedly in vinegar water and/or hanging it outside for a month or so before dry-cleaning. For the worst sprays, it may be best to discard clothing.
